### Dear Parents/ Guardians

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you again for choosing St Teresa of Lisieux for your child's education.

Ordinarily, we would be writing to you to invite you to a number of events to welcome you to our school and meet your child's Class Teacher before the end of this academic year. However, due to the current situation this is not possible.

We find ourselves in an unprecedented set of circumstances and understand the anxieties you may have about your child's transition into Reception. We would like to assure you that an induction process will take place when it is safe to do so. Schools are working within a constantly changing environment and receive regular updates from the Department for Education. We would like to thank you for your patience whilst we put together our plans - which we believe are practical and above-all mutually beneficial in supporting the best possible start to your child's school life.

Due to the current situation we have decided to postpone your child's transition until September when it is, hopefully, safer to do so. This plan is based on the idea that restrictions upon class sizes and social distancing will have been reduced by September and we can provide a smooth and effective transition period for your child. We are, however, obliged to follow current Government and Local Authority guidance and this plan may be subject to change – if this happens then we will notify you in due course.

You will have already received a telephone call, if we have been able to contact you, to gather some basic information about your child from the EYFS Leader and we have already contacted pre-school and nursery settings, as we always do, to find out about your child's learning and development. This means that we have been able to gather a clear picture of the children joining our school in September.

You are invited to attend a Parent Meeting, in school, to meet your child's class teacher and see your child's new classroom.

These meetings will take place on;

- Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September
- Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September

You will be able to book an appointment time that suits you through the School Parent App – if you have not yet downloaded this app then please do so as it is our primary way of communicating important information with parents/guardians. The app is available through The App Store and on Google Play – search for 'PA Connect'.

Your child will then attend three transition and settling in sessions – where they will attend school for half of the day (either morning or afternoon). These sessions will allow your child to settle into school in reduced class sizes under reduced timings.

- Morning sessions will take place between 9.00am − 11.00am
- o Afternoon sessions will take place between 1.00pm 3.00pm

These sessions will take place on;

- Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September
- Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September
- Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September

You will be informed about whether your child should attend the morning or afternoon sessions.

From Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September your child will attend school for the full day.

We believe that this plan will allow your child to settle quickly into our school and get to know their new environment, friends and teachers through more relaxed and subtle conditions.

Before we meet you for your Parents Meeting we have included in this email a series of other important documents;

**Welcome Information PowerPoint** – this includes all of the information which we would normally share with you in a meeting this term – it summarises key information that you will need to be aware of before your child starts school, including timings, uniform and lunch arrangements.

**Preparing Your Child for Starting School** – this document contains general advice and lets you know what to expect when your child starts school – it also includes useful tips and activities to try at home to prepare your child for full time education.
