Your child has these flash cards in their book bag along with a set of green words in their homework book, there is a pack of Set 2 sounds available to be collected from the school office for each child.



#### We listen to God's Word when we gather at Mass.



Talk about how, at Mass, people gather together to hear God's Word and know they are loved by God. Sometimes children go out of church with one of the parish catechists to listen to the Word of God that they can understand at the Children's Liturgy of the Word. The adults stay behind in church to listen to God's Word being proclaimed at the Lectern by a reader and to hear the Gospel being proclaimed by the Priest or Deacon.


Talk about what is happening in the pictures. Who and what do you see? What are they doing? Can you see the *lectern* that the lady is reading from?





Look at the picture below. It shows a story from the Gospel (Mark 10: 13, 14-16). Jesus loved everyone, he was kind and gentle. Parents and carers brought their children to Jesus for him to bless. When the children saw him, they wanted to go to him to listen to his stories and just be with him. Some people thought the children should not be bothering Jesus, but Jesus loved all the children and said, "Let the children come to me." So, the children gathered round Jesus and loved being with Jesus. He gave them a blessing. Jesus loved the children.

This is one of the Gospel stories that we listen to in Church.




Activities to choose:

- Talk about the story of Jesus and the children together and re-enact it using small figures.
- Cut out the small picture of Jesus and stick it in the middle of a piece of paper. Draw a picture of yourself and your friends around Jesus. Put in a speech bubble what you would say to Jesus?

Some questions to think about and answer......

- Q In the story how does Jesus welcome the children? (smiling, places his hand on a child, someone on Jesus' knee, someone leaning on him)
- Q What do you think Jesus might be saying to the children?
- Q Why did the children want to be near Jesus? Would you like to be there too, why?
- Q What does the story tell you about Jesus?
