The Archbishop of Liverpool announced on Tuesday 6 July 2021 that His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed Canon Thomas Neylon of the Archdiocese of Liverpool to be Bishop of Plestia and Auxiliary Bishop of Liverpool. The Archbishop has confirmed that he will ordain Canon Neylon as Bishop on **Friday, 3rd September at 12noon in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King**. There will be unreserved seats in the Cathedral for people who wish to attend, and whilst tickets are not being issued, it would be helpful if anyone intending to celebrate this special occasion and will be attending the Mass should be advised to register their interest by emailing c.hanlon@metcathedral.org.uk

Advice to parishes in the Archdiocese of Liverpool

Due to the fact that the pandemic is far from over it is not the intention to restore an obligation to the attendance at Sunday Mass at this point but it is important keep Sunday holy and if possible attend Mass weekly.

In preparation for the legal changes to Covid regulations that will come in to force on Monday July 19th this is what is being offered as the way forward for each parish in the Archdiocese.

- Social distancing will not be mandatory in our churches but we will keep a section for those who would feel safer and less vulnerable by maintaining socially distanced benches.
- Face coverings will remain for all those coming to a church service. (Exemptions for medical reasons excluded.)
- Hand sanitising will remain necessary as people arrive and a steward will remind people to do this. (There will be no need to sanitise benches or people at the end.)
- A steward will invite people to the Communion procession row by row.
- Singing can be restored.
- The collection basket/plate should not be passed around.
- The Procession of Gifts may be restored (encouraging the use of sanitiser.)
- The sign of peace can be restored but without any touching, ie by a gesture.
